OUR MISSION

To audit and report to the President and Parliament, in accordance with the law, on the proper accounting of public moneys and use of public resources so as to enhance public accountability.

WHO WE ARE

The Auditor-General (AG) is appointed by the President. His duties and responsibilities (including the scope and coverage of his audits) are spelt out in the Constitution and the Audit Act.

The annual Report of the Auditor-General is submitted to the President.

To ensure that the AG can carry out his audits without fear or favour, provisions in the Constitution protect his independence. This enables the AG to perform his duties effectively thereby enhancing public accountability in the use of public funds and resources.



WHO WE AUDIT

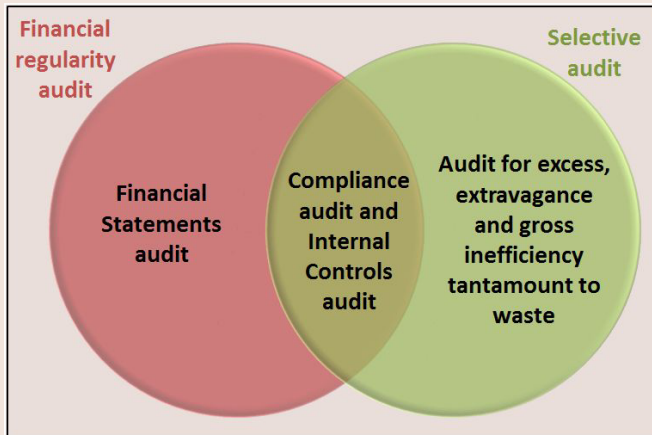
They include:

- Government ministries and departments
- Organs of state
- Statutory boards
- Government funds
- Other public authorities and bodies administering public funds (upon their request for audit), e.g. certain government-owned companies

WHAT WE AUDIT

As the national auditor, our role extends beyond the typical checks of financial accounts and records which are also carried out by commercial auditors.

We carry out financial regularity audits and selective audits in relation to the accounts:



OUR REPORTS

We report our audit observations to:

- Management of the organisation audited through **management letters**
- The President, Parliament and the public through the annual **Report of the Auditor-General**

Our observations include system weaknesses, non-compliance with control procedures or legislation, instances of excess, extravagance, or gross inefficiency tantamount to waste in the use of public funds and resources.

INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATIONS



AGO is a member of INTOSAI (International Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions), which is the umbrella organisation for national audit offices around the world. INTOSAI provides the forum for national audit offices to share experiences and discuss issues. It also offers training and issues guidelines on government auditing and accountability.



AGO is also a member of ASOSAI (Asian Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions), which is one of the seven regional working groups of INTOSAI.
